A reminder that tomorrow is Academic Review Day. Children only come into school at their appointment time with their parent. Class teachers are looking forward to meeting with you.

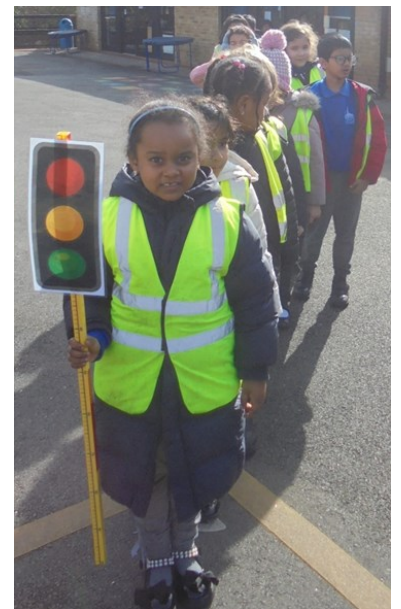
