Do you have school uniform that your child has grown out of?

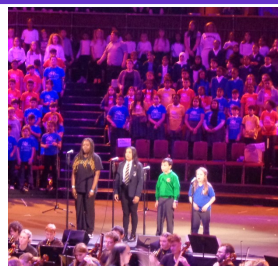

This week Year 2 and Year 5 presented some of their learning to their families. Children showed our Christian Value of 'inspiration' through their confident performances and impressive acting skills.

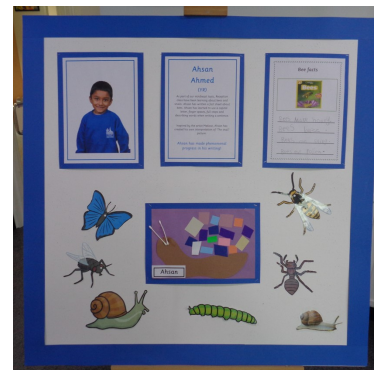


Work of the Week...
