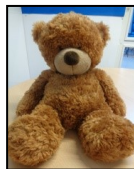
Partnership Football Tournament...

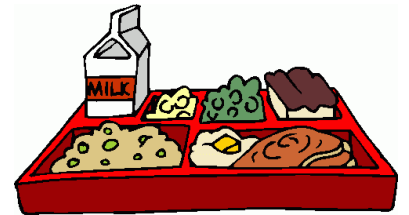
School lunches...

Camden have told us that the price of a school lunch from 17th April (summer term) will be **£2.52 per meal**. This applies to all paid school lunches in Nursery, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6, unless parents are eligible for Free School Meals.

Free School Meals for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will continue.

You may be eligible for Free School Meals so please apply at <https://www.camden.gov.uk/free-school-meals> or pop into the office to ask for a paper form.

The Mayor of London announced plans for all children in primary schools to receive free school meals in the next school year and we will confirm that once we have been given information about when that will start.



Work of the Week...

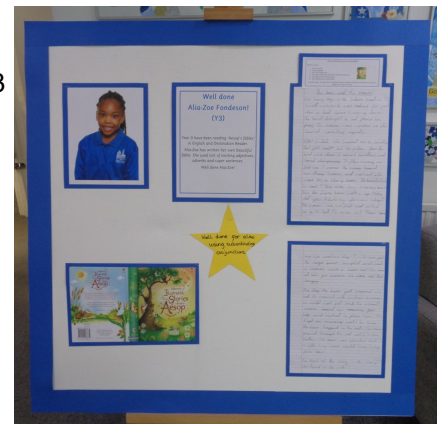


Every week a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby.
