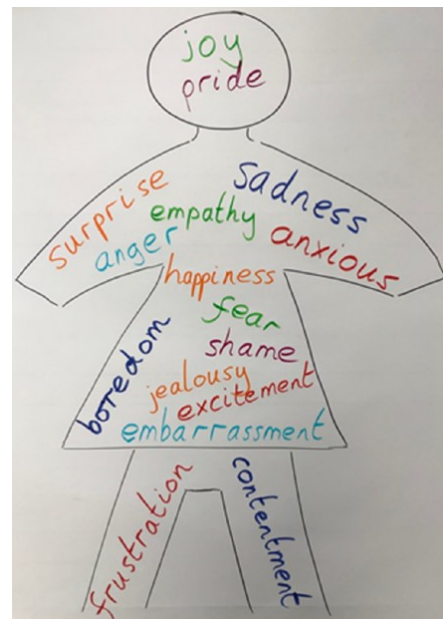
All of the children made us feel very proud as they showed their school Christian values of 'Inspiration' and 'Excellence' during their highly entertaining performances.
