## Work of the Week...

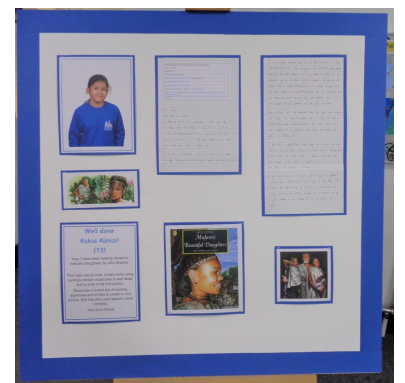


Every week a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby.
