Tickets are limited for health and safety reasons.

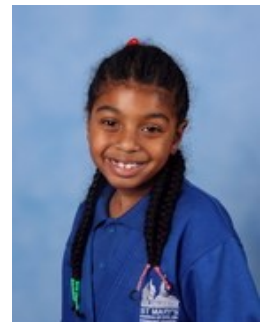
