A reminder that today is the last day of term. We are looking forward to seeing all children back at school on Monday 13th April. Wishing all of our families a Happy Easter

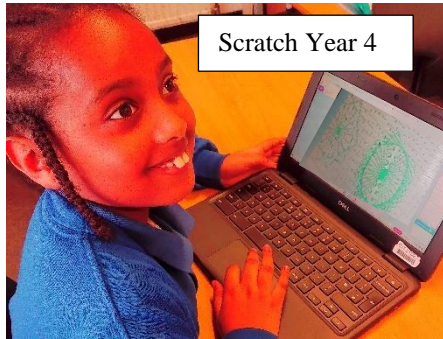

Computing at St Mary's

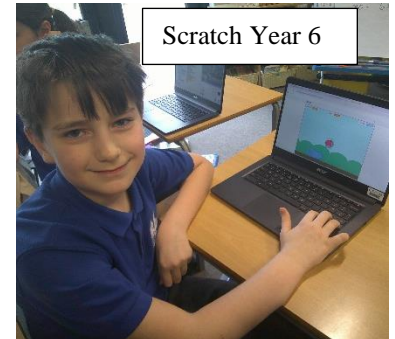
