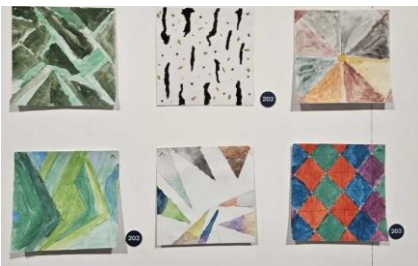

We are always really pleased to meet with you and chat things through.

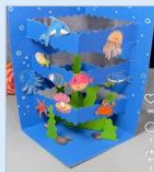
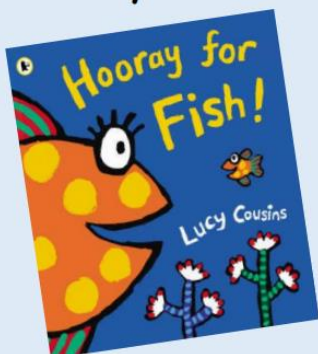
