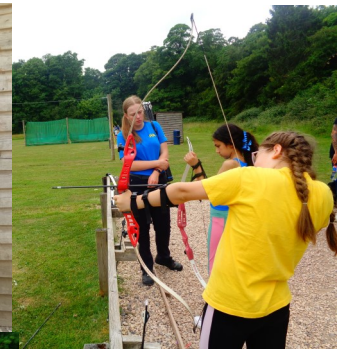
We welcome Mr Blackett, who will be joining St Mary's as a class teacher. Mr Blackett is an experienced teacher and is looking forward to meeting all of you.
